

## Inside Scoop

If you want to ignore our advice and spend most of your time in the Salt Lake City area ensconced in the "Greatest



Snow on Earth," you should know about the Ski Salt Lake Super Pass. Buy either two or

six days of access within a seven-day window to Alta, Snowbird, Brighton and Solitude. The pass comes with complete access to Utah's excellent rail and bus system, which extends all the way to the powder. Get information at ski-saltlake.com.

### HOW TO GET THERE

Northwest Airlines flies to Salt Lake City from its hubs in Minneapolis/St. Paul and Detroit.
